Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sow." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Taurus

You had a history of attaining reliable resources. One of your key impulses was seeking comfort and ownership. Your soul was normally patient to reincarnate, knowing that a lifetime of work couldn't be done in a day. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a stabilizing force. A crucial lesson was not to get stuck. Becoming too attached to what you tasted, touched, smelled and owned kept you from expanding your growth. When you found ways to increase your wealth, it brought you great satisfaction.

There were times you were drawn into the danger lanes. A trickster was telling yourself that whatever came easy was not to be trusted. Life seemed an endless struggle. Finding a way to balance a sober outlook with seeking extreme intensity was a key to your fulfillment. Finding contentment with your desire nature regularly played a major role in your incarnations. You needed to know that you could trust someone with your deepest secrets and with your possessions. Claiming your own power in relationships and in other endeavors, shed great illumination. Betrayal by those you confided in threw you off course. Turning to your own values and resourcefulness pointed the way to wholeness. A tendency to explore life's mysteries deepened your understanding and taught you how to convert negatives into positives.

Node in 3rd house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? It most definitely was anything or anyone that stimulated your mind. If you got too scattered there was a bit of frustration in trying to concentrate. A common concern was "how can I reach the depths of my learning ability?" When you took the time to seek expansive enough life interests, you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? A big one was communication! Following right behind it was an insatiable drive to be educated, whether traditionally or unconventionally. Being a net-worker or broadcaster of a message was another theme. Your energy levels peaked when finding a diversified lifestyle that constantly breathed in refreshing new information. Growing too one-dimensional is what deflated the air out of your balloon. Keeping your eyes on a broad perspective with an eclectic panache is what brought out a free-spiritedness. When you sought to share your knowledge openly this kept you

on track as much as embracing a too narrow belief system was derailing. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks were highly perceptive instincts mixed with a tinge of not really wanting to be limited by reality. When using this wisely and insightfully, life was colored with great variety, never stopping long enough to be bored.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Gemini:

The sign of Gemini the twins lighted the late-spring astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Gemini is "I think". Another being "I perceive". You had a pattern that placed a great emphasis on being free to speak your ideas. Your mind worked fast in previous incarnations.

Archetypes for Gemini include the teacher, advisor and writer. Notice the emphasis on communication. Speaking and learning were next to godliness. You traveled to the Four Corners of the earth to satisfy an undying thirst for knowledge. You found power in being the first to discover a new vein of information. You not only brought and reported the news, on numerous occasions you were the news!

The cosmic principle at work through many of your incarnations was to restlessly express your intellect. You enjoyed a flexible nature that spontaneously moved north, south, east or west when the spirit moved you. Being told there was one way of doing something got you upset. You found ego strength through allowing your perceptions to guide you to those paths filled with excitement and fresh air. A loss of inspiration was what you feared the most. Without this, you couldn't move, like a bird trying to fly without wings. You were meant to soar high above the crowd to let everyone else know what was before them. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting unique perception. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and held the key to self-mastery. It was when you trusted your capacity to figure your way out of any dilemma that this energy was operating at its optimum beauty.

Sun in 2nd house

You had solar power that could be directed with great force to make a plan steadily work in previous lives. Money and power came when you enjoyed the means that led to your objectives. You didn't like to move fast. Though when your ambition realized a chance to strike it rich, you could move in a hurry! Your creative vitality became awakened when you saw ways to stabilize your life. Creature comforts were enjoyed. Feeling reliable gave you a sense of pride.

If there was a challenge, it was overcoming inertia. You could refuse to move when either stubborn or lacking effort. You overcame this when reasoning on your own terms that enough time had been lost. Your self-expression flourished through aesthetics and the joy of watching something grow. The world responded positively when you gave generously of yourself, but negatively when you grew too possessive. Learning who was worthy of your admiration and love was true wisdom. You found fulfillment in balancing give and take.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Leo:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Leo. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual creative power followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a great vitality for self-expression.

Your inner landscapes were filled with treasures of vivid imagination right out of the womb! A dramatic impulse to attract attention was a repeating pattern. A challenge was in not being too self-centered. It was your self-confidence that made people believe in you.

People challenged your power. Avoiding power struggles was another test. Your greatest allies worked with you, rather than against. You took great pride in your accomplishments. Losing was never really an option, but did teach you humility. Risk taking was in your blood. Your subconscious called to you to never lose hope and to intuitively exert your will power.

Moon in 11th house

You had intuitive power when it came to flying away from the flock toward unique horizons. Your pull to be different led you to go against the norm on many occasions. You instinctually knew how to proceed ahead with lightning speed. The exception being that when you became emotionally distraught you lost your compass points. Ascendant: Persona, Identity, Calling Card

Cancer on Ascendant:

With the sign Cancer as your past lives Ascendant, a search for a sense of security frequently colored your incarnations. You were very attached to your home. When you became bonded to a location or home, it took a lot to pry you loose. You moved fast when needing to preserve your sense of security. You were not the easiest person to get to know. revealed your secret agendas to those who won your trust or admiration. Honoring your family ancestry was a heartfelt desire. You frequently looked at the world through eyes that wished to preserve the past. You initiated actions spontaneously when you became fired up over an idea. When you were the catalyst for change, you moved faster than when you were attempting to adjust to changes imposed upon you. You had a need to be with people not afraid to feel deeply. You usually looked for those closest to you to give their support when you needed to meet life's challenges. Remembering to take the time to be happy and appreciate the present was something you always needed to learn.

The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Gemini

You were Mercurialized at birth through the sign of Gemini pointing to speedy mental impulses in past lives. Being excited in speech was your communication style.

You exercised greater patience when knowing you had enough to keep you mentally occupied. Although it should be said, that when you felt overwhelmed by too much stimuli, you didn't fight against a relaxing break in the action. Repetitive routines grew monotonous. You liked doing things simultaneously to test your mental dexterity. Some individuals saw you as lacking depth. Mercury in 2nd house

Venus in Taurus

as symbolizing beauty and calmness. Your social instincts were shaded with a hue of enjoyment in meeting individuals with similar values.

You were attracted to lovers knowing how to make a good living and having the generosity to share their wealth. You didn't like to be rushed to judgment. Where was the rub? You sometimes were accused of being too possessive of those you loved. Then there were those instances when you became obsessed with physical desires. Your romantic fulfillment depended greatly on finding partners able to carry their share of the responsibility, and individuals willing to share your love of peace.

Venus in 3rd house

Communication-friendly lovers attracted your attention, and your way with words got them to notice you. Versatility was what you looked for in people. Rigidity didn't impress you.

You liked to keep your options so open that at times making commitments was testy. You valued not being forced into decisions and liked individuals with a willingness to be open to change. When people listened to you they made you feel valuable. Encouraging those you loved to see the possibilities before them meant a lot to you.

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Leo

What would a warrior planet in the fiery sign of Leo mean regarding your past lives? A ferocious drive to proceed ahead forcefully was what you demonstrated. Patience depended more on whether you thought something was worth seeing through to the end. You could exert incredible will power if fighting for your most passionate desires. Your initiating impulse blasted off when you found your creative power. A competitive spirit was launched when you were determined to bring enterprising ideas to the public. You weren't afraid to take chances though twenty-twenty hindsight did make for embarrassing moments. This didn't really detract from your getting right back to pushing another plan. When maintaining a broad perspective you got to experience the benefit of a wider range of differing perspectives.

Jupiter in 3rd house

Your mind was composed of synapses that danced restlessly to a lively beat. Communication was something you usually excelled at. Spontaneity was exhilarating. It made

Your mind had a great appetite for new information highways. The sheer thrill of visiting foreign environments beyond the borders of routines excited you. Luck smiled favorably upon you when you had the fortitude to trust your ideas. Good fortune came through being adaptable and flowing with life's ups and downs.

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Sagittarius

Ambition came through you enthusiastically, says your past lives history, with Saturn placed in the adventurous sign of Sagittarius. Discipline was another matter. You didn't commit to anything that interfered with your freedom to roam the world in search of greater opportunities. Your greatest fear was being put into confining situations. Knowing where the exits were located was your first concern if you sniffed out a potentially frustrating path. There was a keen interest in education and religion.

Saturn in 8th house

Wisdom came through forgiveness, and in not holding prolonged grudges.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Aries

You had a tendency to act fast on future goals, indicates having Uranus in the sign Aries. Your mind would switch to fast forward when anticipating exciting change. Waiting for things to happen wasn't your first choice. You liked to think for yourself. When told you were not allowed to move toward new paths, you rebelled in a heartbeat. Uranus in 3rd house

In what way were you unconventional? It was in the manner you perceived everyday experiences. Your mind didn't process information like many others, as a matter of fact it was ready to move ahead and worry about details later. A futuristic vision highlighted your thoughts and repeatedly egged you on to reinvent yourself. Your goals were kept in plain view so you could stay stimulated. It wasn't always easy to concentrate on the present, as the seductive presence of new trends captured your awareness in an instant. A sense of direction was more a matter of following in the footsteps of current favorite interests. Planning wasn't one of your assets. Freedom to think independently was godly in your opinion. You rebelled against restrictive rules threatening your autonomy, thinking they were made to be broken. Changing directions on a dime was your style. Racing forward occurred when escaping from boredom. Running toward more exciting horizons did make you somewhat unreliable. You were inventive in discovering a new trend that reflected deep insights. You could see the whole of a process quickly when you became deeply immersed in a subject.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Leo

You believed in ideals that inspired your creative power. Your idealism was awakened through chances to display your talents. An exuberant vitality helped get you through the lean times. Your confidence in others helped them find the faith to pursue their dreams. You benefited from close confidantes promoting you. There were times when you needed to take a risk even when nobody thought you could defeat the odds. Romance ignited a flame in your heart. Falling in love was an incredible high. You liked to celebrate special occasions in a big way. Dramatic types liked you.

A major challenge was finding the ego strength to show your capability. The old saying, "don't hide your light under a bushel" applied here. Running away from challenges didn't please others. There was divine discontent in never really being convinced you gave all you could to loved ones or your pet projects. Making peace with this trait turned out to be wisdom personified. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to have your closest allies admire you. You found transcendental growth through creative pursuits that allowed you to stay young and vibrant in spirit.

Neptune in 11th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to a sense of direction. You could

feel out the way to go. The exception being if you became disillusioned with your world. You became mesmerized by unique thinking individuals. Especially those with a seductive presence, speaking words that encouraged you to transcend ordinary time and place. Your idealism found you seeking unique ideals.

It was when you felt like you were treading water and having no idea how to move forward. You did get fogged when your favorite dreams turned out to be mirages. This often happened after not really facing reality. Faith transformed your denial into an objective gaze at your possibilities. You searched for a purpose that pushed you to vigorously pursue your hopes.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Cancer

Empowering yourself through securing your position in the world was a past lives tendency. When you decided to lay down roots, you found a feeling of permanency. Maintaining a sense of security was a regular pattern. You displayed charisma through an intensity to care about others. There was sometimes a mystery about the way you guarded your privacy. Sudden volatile mood swings were an occasional downfall. You were better received by others when this didn't become an often event. There were times when you swallowed your feelings rather than vent your true opinions.

There was a shadow. What was it? A haunting fear of change, or a loss of someone close. When you found the strength to deal with this side of yourself, you acted with greater spontaneity. Self-mastery was discovered through not projecting your own shortcomings onto others. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when you greeted the present and future as the agents of a ticket to passionate growth, rather than as the disturbers of your comfort zones.

Pluto in 1st house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You did your best to stay a self-determined individual. This simply means you didn't like taking your P's and Q's from others. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through courageously initiating actions. This wasn't necessarily always easy. When opposing forces in the form of people or other circumstances got in your way, it took great fortitude to move ahead. There was a side of you that purposely created daredevil challenges. It became necessary to restrain this urge. You were self-conscious. It angered you to be criticized. Strong partners or friends challenged you to live up to your potential. Though you often didn't need much prodding. A powerful self-examination manifested itself when you weren't happy with your own growth. A compulsive desire to clarify your identity got you to ask thought-provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations connected to fearing that you might actually find out who you really were. When you accepted your need to work on yourself in a positive light, a new revitalized you was born.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon square Jupiter

Your judgment was sometimes questioned when your optimism grew too excessive. Setting limits wasn't your strong suit. But inspiring and persuading was. Your restlessness was a driving force. Becoming judgmental was a shadow. When you stayed clear of this behavior, people liked you. You felt it a mission to share what you knew with others. It was your principles and highest beliefs that guided you. When you were reasonable in what you asked of others, they more easily could meet your expectations. It hurt your feelings when those closest to you didn't support your favorite interests. There were times when you had to go forward with or without approval.

Moon trine Saturn

You accepted responsibility without feeling infringed upon. When you didn't want your life weighed down by someone else's problems, you might run away. People found you easy going and letting life come to you. Some saw you as too relaxed. When you did find an ambitious streak, you were lucky in finding opportunities. You then only had to keep maintaining the effort.

Moon conjunct Neptune

Intuition played a big part in your past. You had an intense yearning to find the deepest meaning possible which led you on spiritual journeys. A search for ideals and symbols that were inspiring was a strong leaning. Romance either made you feel wonderful or filled you with divine discontent. Much depended on your dependency needs. When finding a soul mate, life couldn't have been better. If you became too lost in finding the perfect love, you did lose your clarity. Whatever your life ambitions, you had high aspirations. Staying grounded went far in supporting your achievements. Guilt kept you from enjoying greater happiness. When you did manage to keep this in check, you discovered the power of your inner world, and it was a vast kingdom.

Moon square Node

Your destiny never really unfolded with great certainty or in a linear fashion. It was more like resolving one crisis after another. You got off this merry-go-round when stepping back for a minute to see how to become a watcher without always having to be a reacting player. Emotional power was at your disposal. Getting people to work with you rather than resisting was a key. You needed to watch being overprotective. Your dependency needs easily got too intertwined with those you loved or were attached to. You got drained and burned out when not pacing your energy. Your intuitive gifts were an asset.

Sun conjunct Mercury

You could think fast on your feet. Mental flashes quickly darted across your mind. Some thought you nervous, others brilliantly witty. Details either fascinated you or made you feel crazy. A sense of order was desired so you could clearly decipher how to manifest your creativity. There was a serious meticulous side, combined with a perception of life's absurd ironies. Communication was an area you always could declare bragging rights. If you talked without careful thinking, you did get into trouble. At least one critiquing eye constantly peered out its socket, analyzing fact from fiction. It was critical that you were harder on a problem than on yourself or those you loved.

Sun oppose Saturn

You took your commitments to people seriously. Decisive individuals appealed to you. Controlling individuals tried to make you into who you weren't. You were better loved when

letting those closest to you express their ideas openly. A reserved nature was dominant until warming up to social situations. Spontaneous individuals either loosened you up or made you nervous. Your sense of obligation was strong. A work assignment was done intensely as you were sensitive about having a good reputation. If you leaned too much on others your dependency needs were out of balance. It wasn't always so good if you tried to take the lead in all situations. Trusting that others could perform as well as you lightened your load. Sadness or depression over failed romances did occur. Rejection was a sensitive issue. You were better off when realizing that life wasn't always fair and that love was a learning experience.

Sun square Midheaven

What you wanted to accomplish wasn't always what others had planned for you to do. Clashes with authority figures started early. You had creative power that didn't stop until you finished what you started, that is, if you loved what you were doing. Fighting to preserve your status or jockeying for greater societal position was a pattern. Leadership bored you if there was little challenge or stress. You liked to showoff your talent. If your ego got inflated, you weren't much fun. Patience didn't come in bunches, unless you were convinced delayed gratification was worth the wait. You were a force to be reckoned with when setting your sights on a game plan. Competitors challenged your power regularly. Those closest to you drew nearer when you demonstrated humility. Knowing when to be vulnerable as differentiated from the times to be a mountain, reflected true wisdom.

Mercury square Midheaven

Self-driven to be successful was an innate drive. It was finding the confidence that was testy. You didn't handle criticism so well. Determination grew out of wanting to prove that you could be a success. A high strung nervous streak was typical. You strove for perfection. This either found you reaching great milestones or failing to reach impossible standards. Setting the bar at a reasonable height was smarter than trying to compulsively climb Mount Everest. You needed a lot of mental space in whatever roles you were performing. Close supervision made you uneasy. Performance anxiety sometimes was troubling for fear of failure. When you had the support of lovers and friends your confidence levels did increase greatly.

Mars square Node

When you veered too far from the right paths, life slapped you in the face. It was a wake up call. When walking your talk, clearly the conflict wasn't as abrupt. Living in extremes could occur before you knew what happened. You had a tendency to move fast instinctively, which sometimes worked beautifully. There were occasions when you had to retrace your steps due to lack of foresight. You caused many of your battles through unconscious actions that infuriated others. Though in all fairness, even when you were as clear as the brightest sunny day, enemies challenged your strength. There were lives where you withdrew from struggles. The burnout or exhaustion was replaced with a revitalized self. You had a knack for sensing danger on the horizon. This made you better prepared to defend yourself. A spiritual awakening changed you drastically making you desire to take a burning intensity to a higher level of expression.

Jupiter square Neptune

Your faith could either be impeccable or be filled with holes of doubt. It was escapism that hijacked your happiness. Facing your shortcomings gave you the strength to deal with whatever came your way. You believed in love. Your romances were many. You found the greatest peace when realizing you could survive alone or with that special someone. There was a divine discontent with reality that either drove you to be creative or to become disillusioned. You detested limits. Whatever you could imagine you thought possible to accomplish. An intense desire to follow a spiritual path suddenly came upon you. There was conflict in chasing what the world offered and satisfying an inner longing for peace. You weren't easy to live with because you were so changeable in likes and dislikes. When you did become content, you had to stay grounded to really let the experience engulf you. Ideals inspired your creativity.

Saturn trine Neptune

Ambition and imagination were in a groove for the most part. You had big dreams but didn't always pursue them. You enjoyed roles that gave you a sense of purpose. Facing issues made you stronger.

Uranus square Pluto

Conflict regarding a fight for your freedom was a theme that repeated often. You detested people trying to manipulate you. Your intensity to move forward with little fear of the consequences was a pattern. You had desires for taking chances and experimenting wildly that didn't exactly make for a simple life. If things became too comfortable or easy, you didn't trust them. Your friends and lovers usually possessed some of the same intensity. It wasn't in your nature to compromise, unless forced into situations where you didn't have much choice. Though when it came to overcoming bad experiences, you had a way of blasting off into new directions. You didn't like to take the time to process the past because you were so busy living in the next moment!

Uranus square Ascendant

Ideas traveled through you at the speed of light, sometimes causing you to ride one suddenly onto a new highway. Your fast changes of direction made some think you to be undependable. You enjoyed shocking others with actions and thought-provoking ideas. It wasn't in your nature to be a copycat. You were trend setting for sure. Causing friction with no real purpose behind the action wasn't productive. You were quite a catalyst for change. Erratic inconsistencies in behavior proved problematic in maintaining closeness or finishing what you started out to do. When you discovered your unique personal style it did find you with a clearer sense of direction.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its

meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.**Gemini on 2nd House:**

A tendency to find multiple ways to earn a living was a reality. Your mind was always considered to be your most valuable resource. You didn't like to have your choices forced down your throat. Mental determination came forward when you discovered a life purpose. An unwillingness or inability to be disciplined frustrated you and others. Developing shortcuts that saved time and money served you well in your past. You admired those individuals able to concretely express their ideas. When people listened to your concepts it won your heart. People who thought before they acted made you feel more at ease with them.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.**Aries on 3rd house:**

A competitive mind colored your mental impulses. Patience with the ideas of others didn't usually come easily. People were attracted to your courageous insights. Twenty-twenty hindsight yielded embarrassing results. Your mind had a pattern of moving in fast forward. Your past life tendency was to learn new information your own way. Seeing opposing points of view did not always come naturally. Tolerance usually won you the right allies. Your thoughts energized others. Individuals with passive minds didn't move you as much as those speaking freely.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.**Pisces on 4th house:**

You idealized those you loved, unless you became very disillusioned. Reality checks now and then were important to make sure your perceptions of people were accurate. Hiding from the truth caused problems. People sometimes depended on you greatly for emotional support. You needed to be careful in knowing your boundaries or you would give until completely depleted. You enjoyed retreats away from having to feel responsible for others. This was your way of getting recharged. Your sense of security rested upon the faith you had in yourself. You found strength in your ideals.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.**Aquarius on 5th house:**

You boldly expressed ideas. You could be fair on one hand, while arrogant on the other. When it came to defending your rights, you could be quite direct. Inventiveness often blessed you in one life after another. Romances had their ups and downs. You were not always sure just how committed to a lover you cared to be. Freedom needs dictated just how you responded to a partner. You demanded a lot of attention. Developing consistency didn't come easily. When you managed to master your rebellious energy, you could channel it into productive outlets quite

successfully. You lived much of the time for your future goals. The present was more tolerable if it met the expectations of your need for opportunity. Some saw you as unreasonable because you hated restrictions. Others envied and admired in the same breath the example you set as far as walking your talk.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.
Aquarius on 6th house:

You didn't like to get bogged down by the ordinary details. You did your best to sidestep them. Sometimes you lived for learning new skills. Work environments that challenged you mentally kept you interested. A tendency to quickly outgrow situations kept you moving from one form of work to another. When you didn't beat to your own drum, you got real nervous and even accident-prone. Your mind tested reality to see if it could pave the way for a more interesting future. You were not as happy when letting others talk you out of your most important goals. When you did get situated and find the right niches, you could express a very focused mind. Settling for less occurred due to a lack of confidence related to being critiqued by the wrong people. When you trusted your instincts to act, rather than to think only, you were successful beyond measure.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.
Capricorn on 7th house:

You preferred relationships that were stable. Trust didn't come easily, but with time, you did manage to warm up to your fair share of mates. Time was your ally in romance because you needed this to deepen your commitments. You didn't impulsively rush into partnerships. Your love relationships got out of balance if you treated someone too businesslike, rather than as a lover. When you exhibited a cold personality it was more out of fear. Some of your partners were a bit reserved. You chose to live alone at times because this made it easier than trying to please someone. A resistance to a lover's need for new experiences did cause tension. There were times when a lack of flexibility in a lover put considerable pressure on you. You did sometimes learn that trying to control others didn't bring them closer. People that didn't let your seriousness bother them often became your friends. Your bark was louder than your bite. Finding ways to stay playful kept your relationships longer lasting. Balanced dependency needs was important to the stability of a partnership.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.
Sagittarius on 8th house:

You preferred generous partners. Trust was something you worshiped. This meant you didn't have much use for those betraying you. You cut people a lot of slack until they hung themselves. You had deep convictions about your beliefs. You had luck in the nick of time to escape close calls. Avoiding dangerous situations through following spontaneous instincts kept you free of harm's way. The exception was when you carelessly overlooked the odds. Life went better when you tolerated the freedom needs of others. There was a tendency to be overly idealistic. Reality testing helped.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.**Libra on 9th house:**

You were torn between chasing after a dream and pleasing others. Cleverness in figuring out how to have both was within your grasp. You grew confused the most when letting someone talk you out of your belief system. This was when great indecision would surface. You didn't always care to know the truth about situations because it pressured you into doing what was right. Your ethics did guide you to find friends and lovers with similar values.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.**Virgo on 10th house:**

Worrying compulsively about the outcome of things did surface. When you delegated work to others, it took a lot of stress off of you. Learning how to let go and trust that life would turn out for the best wasn't easy. Being a workaholic was something you needed to be on the guard about. It was easy for you to forget to pace yourself. You lived longer when you listened and respected your body's plea for a break in the action. The perfection you put into your work did get others to take notice. It was important to realize to know when to stop perfecting. When you believed in your ability, great things happened.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.**Leo on 11th house:**

You approached the future like it was something to conquer. You would roar like a lion when people were infringing upon your rights. Anyone squatting too far into your territory was looking for a fight. Your goals were characteristically self-centered. This didn't bother your lovers and closest friends as long as you weren't too ruthless in going after your aspirations. Your vision could be disruptive of the routines of those not liking your suggestions. Patience was a challenge. In a lifetime or two you were a notorious gambler. Learning to look before leaping was wise. Getting close to you was not all that easy when you were too much in love with your independence. People liked you more when you accepted their right to disagree. Your creative spirit never liked to be held back for long!

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.**Leo on 12th house:**

You were in love with your causes. It wasn't like you to do things halfway. A true romantic you often were. Finding a soul mate sharing your heartfelt need for self-expression was a constant factor. It was important that you didn't overly exaggerate your potential. Promising more than you could deliver did cause a few embarrassing situations. Falling in love with individuals pretending to admire you was another past lives theme. It usually became apparent to you, sooner or later, that not everyone could be trusted when it came to matters of the heart. You tuned into your intuitive nature in two ways. One was when you were madly in love. The other being when you passionately expressed your creativity. It was when you ignored that there were physical limits that your body suffered. Your will power to live boldly could

compensate for occasional bad judgment. You had a habit of not wanting to hear the word no when you were determined to go ahead with a plan. You did impress people with fiery enthusiasm, spontaneously putting an ideal into action. Although a lack of ego strength did cause you to lack the courage to take on a new challenge. When you transcended this tendency, you reclaimed your creative power.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Mercury Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in keeping your thoughts positive. Your analytical side was well developed more often than not. A tendency to instinctively rethink your decisions was a trait. Knowing when to stop trying to perfect a task was essential to your happiness. You became nervous if rushed into decisions. Instant recall of facts happened when you least expected it. There was a need to feel like you could control the pace of your mind. You weren't bothered by information overload, as long as it was facts of your choosing, or preference. The challenge was to stay clear of becoming compulsively negative in your thinking. When you felt mentally at ease and clear, life seemed good.

Saturn retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had much to learn regarding flexibility versus rigidity. These two opposites were a sore spot of contention. A tendency to get extremely focused when you enjoyed a role was a past pattern. You were happier when feeling in control of your life. Knowing when to show vulnerability and when to show a tough set of armor was wisdom indeed! Some thought you lacked ambition. What they didn't see working behind the scenes was your inner search to find professions and directions that seemed worth the effort. An inclination toward becoming a one-dimensional workaholic was a potential trap. Remembering that life was a multidimensional panorama made for happier times. There was a need to steer clear of icebergs that brought depression and feelings of rejection. Responding with courage to your commitments lessened your anxiety about them. It was in not letting fear keep you from the love and success you painfully wanted that you reached the highest of milestones.
