Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sow." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Gemini

You had a history of moving in multiple directions simultaneously. One of your key impulses was seeking ways to satisfy a curious mind. Your soul was normally restless to reincarnate, not so much concerned with the final objectives, as much as enjoying the life journey. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a stimulating force. A crucial lesson was not to get distracted from the main work to be done. Your mind couldn't help but seek paths that kept you from getting bored. Keeping your life exciting was as important to you as pragmatic realities. Losing your focus was when you had to develop concentration and discipline.

When you became too mundane, it was a normal occurrence that the gypsy within reminded you that it was time to find adventure. A trickster was that all roads led to Rome. Procrastination resulted. Finding a way to balance an insatiable hunt for knowledge while staying focused was a key to fulfillment. You required more on your mental plate than most in your incarnations. People and places awakened a spirit of adventure. Without this, you didn't feel quite right, like something important was missing. The path felt more complete when you gave yourself the freedom to keep the doors opened that led to eclectic knowledge and exhilarating opportunity.

Node in 10th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Reaching for the pinnacle of success was what lit up your life regularly. If you feared failure it delayed your chances to get ahead. Another important theme was building a home life that was a source of your strength. A common concern was "how do I determine those roles that will make me happy?" When you didn't become overly consumed with work you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Leadership positions pumped up your adrenaline. A chance to wield power did at times entice you. Management was a key expression. Your energy levels peaked when your ambition was awakened. If you sacrificed or ignored the people who loved you, you later paid the consequences. When balancing your private and public lives, it kept you on track as much as becoming a workaholic or isolationist

was in many instances self-defeating. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks was raw persevering instinct mixed with a tinge of strong intuition, shaping your life with determination on one hand, and a window for mystery on the other. When using this wisely and patiently, life was colored with worthwhile milestones and dependable partners.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Libra:

The sign of Libra, symbolized by the scales, lighted the early-fall astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Libra is "I balance". You had a repeating pattern in dealing with the dilemma of figuring out opposing opinions. The fallout that came afterwards was indecision in that each choice looked just as good as the other.

Archetypes for Libra include the diplomat, lover and artist. You often got a chance to mediate disputes in previous lives. Greater happiness came through decisive action.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your incarnations was to seek approval from others. It was only when this became compulsive that you got into trouble. Another key theme was partnerships. Relationships played a big role. Finding a sign mate was a quest, and in some lives you felt incomplete without one. When you didn't look for too much of yourself in someone else, your relationships yielded greater harmony. The arts were an outlet for your creative impulses and awakened your senses. You found ego strength through falling in love and expressing passionate ideas. Though not a fighter at heart, you did make war when you wanted to defeat a competitive adversary. You have come into this life solarized through a sign promoting gracefulness and refined social instincts. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to self-mastery. When you had the wisdom to think for yourself and yet hear the voices of those who loved you, your days were less lonely.

Sun in 5th house

You had solar power that soared through you with great force in previous lives. Being in the spotlight was what you desired. Your ego got bruised easily if not receiving enough attention. You were as dramatic as you were fiery. A drive to promote came as naturally as snow falling on top of the Rocky Mountains in mid winter. Your creative vitality was ready to reload on a moment's notice. Being in love did arouse your energy. Being a follower wasn't as easy as striving to be a leader. You needed lots of elbowroom to work. A take control type you were. You were extremely proud of your creations. Getting too attached to offspring or creations happened regularly. Directing others to be successful was part of your history.

If there was a challenge it was in two separate camps. One was being too bossy. The other was a lack of confidence. In most lives you vacillated between the two. When you found the right roles, look out! You were ready to shoot a full throttle to make up for lost time. The actor and director lived brightly through you. When you moved with self-assuredness, others were ready to follow. However, if you took too big of a risk or showed great arrogance, you sometimes looked back and realized you were alone. Your self-expression burst onto the scene loudly when your ability was recognized. You only needed to fall in love with what you liked

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Virgo:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Virgo. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual work drive has followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a dedication to excellence along with a tendency to worry.

Your inner landscapes were lined with a strong work ethic. Refining your work skills was an intense drive. A meticulous concern for details was a blessing and a curse. You did out produce many with a precision-like approach to getting a job accomplished. Though trying to be too perfect made life difficult for you and those trying to live with you. Moon in 6th house

Venus: Relationships, Values, Comfort.

Venus in Sagittarius

Many people experienced you as symbolizing free-spiritedness and adaptability. Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Scorpio

Although when you couldn't find the right outlets to express the passion you felt, it was like living in a pressure cooker sitting on top of a hot flame.

Jupiter in 5th house

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Leo

Ambition came through you with thunderous force, says your past lives history, with Saturn placed in the dramatic sign of Leo. Discipline followed after you plunged passionately into your most creative endeavors. You didn't like taking a backseat to anyone. Pride in your accomplishments was your style. It didn't hurt your feelings if people applauded loudly. The rub was when they didn't acknowledge your talents quickly enough. But let it be said you were willing to cheer on others in return. Your greatest fear was rejection. It devastated you, especially in romance. When you realized that not everyone would love you unconditionally, guess what happened? You found happiness faster.

A karmic shadow was being too overconfident in some lives, while lacking ego strength in others. How could both be possible? There were times when you steam rolled your desires over others. Then there were lives when you lacked belief in your ability to the point of hiding your talent. Finding that middle ground of inner faith took you out of this challenge. You often defined yourself through professions allowing you to exercise your full creative capacity, and as someone with an endless amount of vitality.

Saturn in 8th house

What was your main focus? It was personal empowerment, whether through wealth or partnerships. Balancing dependency needs was a key to happiness. You consistently asked at crucial points during an incarnation: how do I secure my position of power? Survival instincts were usually strong. Determining just how close to live near the edge gave you a sense of control. Rigidity in negotiation sometimes produced karmic woes. The antidote was greater flexibility in this area, that is, when you were determined not to repeat the same old lessons you needed to learn. You sometimes hid your true agendas due to a lack of trust. When becoming dictatorial people didn't like you. Business savvy was at your fingertips.

You learned it was important to manage your time wisely. You eventually were hungry for self-mastery. Conquering irrational fears was liberating. A major redefining occurred in lifetimes that was associated with rebirth, or a sense of renewal. Channeling negatives into positives was a type of transformation. Wisdom came through forgiveness, and in not holding prolonged grudges.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Gemini

You had a tendency to think excitedly about future goals, indicates having Uranus in the sign Gemini. Your mind did switch to fast forward when talking about ideas and when getting an opportunity to learn new information. Communication was an arena that you knew well. You had unique insights into situations that often outreached others. It wasn't always easy to fit into traditional social norms as you often had a foot in unconventional thinking. You had laser-like perceptions that could cut through to original material quickly. You sometimes had a rebellious streak due to feeling unaccepted by the status quo.

Uranus in 10th house

In what way were you unconventional? That's an easy one to answer, you were a distinct individual in whatever role you viewed as important. You were aloof concerning what you didn't value. People occasionally found you emotionally absent. You had futuristic vision that burned a hole right through the skeleton of most institutions. You reinvented yourself through professions that reflected your genius or most outrageous beliefs. Fighting city hall was a mantra. A sense of direction was an in the moment experience. You liked living in the present with one foot safely in tomorrow's promising skies. You weren't so available to be counted on for support by others. If you didn't trust your own insights there was a tendency to get stuck in confining roles. It was impossible to be happy if letting someone control your thinking. Innovative events and people made your internal clocks turn electrically ahead. You stood firm if you perceived that it was not in your best interest to make adjustments. It was that you grew bored which led to sarcasm. Inventive circuitry ran throughout your brain. You often were so far out in front of the pack that nobody knew what to make of your knowledge. Finding ways to be part of mainstream life of a tribe or city was a challenge.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Libra

You believed in ideals that symbolized fairness and justice for all. Your idealism was awakened through the individuals believing in you, and the ones you admired. Talents in the arts were shown in several lives. You liked individuals possessing diplomacy and tact. Stress annoyed you if lasting too long. Denying there was any problems never resolved anything. Romance was a great calling. Love was almost a religion. You liked exotic partners and those willing to move quickly in an atmosphere of celebration. Falling in love with a lack of reality testing was not in your best interest.

A major challenge was in defining the boundaries between you and others. Guilt made you feel too responsible for a person's troubles. Wearing rose colored glasses painted false first impressions of individuals, letting you see what only you chose to perceive. There were times when you could see right into the soul of someone. When you were honest with yourself, you gravitated to the right peers and lovers. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to get opportunities to express your gifts and to find a special someone that recognized the true you. You found transcendental growth through not trying to overly please others, and by having the faith to proceed ahead with your most determined effort.

Neptune in 6th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to learning new skills and self-improvement in general. You had high standards about efficiency, but didn't always have clearly defined paths for getting organized. You became mesmerized when watching others excel in what you desired to learn. The healing arts held a special place in your heart, as did a devotional life. Diet and health became special interests in some lives. Your idealism inspired you to follow certain causes.

A test was learning how to select what was worth your sacrifice of time, energy and at times wealth. The boundary between common sense and wearing "strawberry fields" colored glasses was not usually very thick. Rolling up your sleeves to take on a difficult project came when feeling the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality kept you mentally centered and strong. What was the biggest challenge? Without a doubt, perfection! It plagued you when trying to defy reasonable expectations. You were happier if not expecting the impossible. You were driven to escapism if not modifying your standards. Faith transformed your denial of reality into a more balanced expression. You searched for a purpose that helped you walk without guilt, and strengthened your resolve to accept life's ups and downs.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Leo

Empowering yourself through creative risk-taking was a past lives tendency. A strong drive to make your plans ring true was forever pulsating through you. Finding pride through giving birth to ideas was a regular pattern. Cheering and promoting emanated from you loudly. You shined brightly with charisma when your accomplishments were recognized. Your enthusiasm often swept people into believing in you. Growing too attached to what you loved was an occasional downfall. Maintaining some objective distance from lovers and your creations made you easier to like.

There was a shadow. What was it? A fear of losing. When your skin toughened up enough to at least accept a small dose of rejection, you didn't suffer as much. You could fight endlessly to make others accept your proposals and deals. In the end, you had to decide which battles to wage. In some incarnations you actually lacked the confidence to be successful. Therefore, in this latter case you had to find ways to allow the talent to develop. Self-mastery was discovered through allowing authentic self-expression beam brightly from you. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when listening to your heart, rather than the fear of your self-doubt.

Pluto in 8th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? It was through knowing whom you could trust. This was a testy subject for you. Usually, you had only one true confidante in a lifetime. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through achieving self-mastery. It was often a surprise for you to find you had untapped talent. The people you met awakened your creative power. Your survival skills instinctually became activated when you were a victim of betrayal. Forgiving others was difficult after they abused your trust. Your relationships did at times find you attracted to intense individuals that weren't exactly stabilizing. In any event, you often grew stronger after dealing with a crisis. A powerful self-examination manifested itself following emotional upheavals. Losing what you were attached to was quite painful. When you found a way to successfully grieve through the past, a new life awaited. A compulsive tendency to fear losing everything you owned got you to ask thought-provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations, an obsessive fixation on loss or death. You relaxed more into confident roles when you channeled this thought power into meaningful action.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon square Uranus

Emotional upheavals were a pattern. You needed a lot of space in close relationships. When you were successful in sustaining long term commitments there was still much space needed. Getting bored easily made it a must to find freedom-oriented living conditions. You rebelled quickly against being controlled. You liked surrounding yourself with new trends and progressive minds.

Moon trine Midheaven

There was luck in landing in the right town at the right time. Your intuition told you when and where to move, that is, if you quieted down enough to hear it. Passivity did water down

your ambition, now and then. Overall you normally enjoyed a stable home life along with worthwhile work.

Sun conjunct Jupiter

You were a philosopher, student and gypsy, over and over again. Travel appealed to you. Discipline didn't come easily, unless you were real motivated. Some accused you of laziness while you explained this as being laid back. When inspired, you held your own. You held strong opinions and hated being wrong. You were at your best when developing a broad-based vision, not bothered by a few forks in the road. A youthful idealism made you ask life for a lot. Denying your shortcomings or problems was common. It was a positive attitude that brought you immense luck and even wealth.

Mercury conjunct Mars

Thoughts flew through your mind at the speed of light. You could change directions quickly. Making sure you didn't jump to conclusions was a challenge. You had razor sharp perceptions that sometimes made others uneasy. Your nerves got on edge easily so you were better when not sitting and worrying for prolonged time periods. Patience was a test. Angry outbursts got better mileage when you learned how to better express this intensity.

Mercury oppose Midheaven

Your communication skills were regularly utilized in your work. You had a way of sensing as to how to best serve the public. You functioned better when not being subjected to intense criticism. Your determination for success usually developed slowly, and gained strength as you found your footing. In leadership positions, you had a keen eye for detail. Self-confidence was a challenge. You weren't the easiest person to work with until you gained patience. The more successful you became, the more generosity you showed toward others. It was when you stayed mentally cool during a crisis that others liked you.

Mercury square Ascendant

Communication clashes were inevitable because your ideas didn't exactly fit right into everyone else's expectations. Taking a risk that stretched beyond everyday logic raised a few eyebrows. You didn't mind taking the heat as long as it got you the results. Your nervous system could get as tense as stretching out a rubber band right up to its breaking point. Cool-down periods were required to get you recharged, more like a quick pit stop and right back into the race! You had a mind that could readily shred someone's plans. Being the critic upset those that loved you. Toning down and being more accepting of a few flaws made for more peace. When you were filled with self-doubt was when the road was rocky. A positive outlook attracted better people and life experiences.

Venus oppose Midheaven

Finding the right balance between home and work was important to you. You were sensitive about getting emotional support from those you loved. Doubting your decisions was something you had to overcome if you were going to be happy. You liked having a soul mate or a special someone with whom to share ideas. A team spirit gave you greater confidence. Living up to the expectations of others was a challenge. You were more content when becoming your own person.

Mars square Pluto

Danger intrigued you. Taking risks was a high. If you listened to the wrong advice you rushed into reckless actions. When you put this raw energy to wise use there was nothing you couldn't do. You were a passionate person needing big challenges in order to feel alive. Self-destructive actions had to be watched. Knowing ahead of time which actions wouldn't get you into trouble came with experience. Allowing loved ones get to know the real you was scary, but liberating.

Mars oppose Midheaven

Self-confidence came with each little success. It was the pressure in trying to meet the expectations of others that made you uneasy. You had a competitive side but it needed a lot of encouragement to come forward. There was a bit of performance anxiety. You made a good leader when you didn't doubt yourself. Knowing when to push others and when to back off brought out the best in those you tried to help. You were a late bloomer but this doesn't mean you didn't accomplish your serious plans. Fighting those in authority wasn't always wise. Then again, being a doormat for others grew old real fast. You were the most content when finding those skills that released the intensity of your potential. Settling into a home environment that energized your identity and one that made you feel needed, were the grounding forces.

Mars square Ascendant

Moving fast was how you lived. You pressured yourself into competing with others. Angry outbursts were commonplace. You did have a problem in overreacting to situations. The good news was when you needed to be feisty and warlike, the trigger was already pulled back and ready to fire at adversaries. You sometimes were your own worst enemy in being angry at yourself. When you had places to channel this very restless energy, you were more productive. Having plenty to do was a basic requirement in keeping you centered. Insight into your actions helped intercept negative impulses before they exploded. You were courageous in exploring uncharted territories.

Jupiter square Saturn

Happy one day and sad the next. This was a pattern in some lives. You lived in extremes. Finding that place in between great joy and sober reality was the challenge. You had high

expectations. Authority figures clashed with your optimism. You needed to be careful not to automatically dash someone else's hopes and dreams with negativity. The work world got you to pin many of your dreams on it. This worked fine when you were a success. It was depressing when you failed. Having beliefs that sustained you in the lean seasons was paramount in importance. You had a conflict when you dreadfully feared losing. Taking small clear steps toward a plan often delivered the best results. Not taking yourself so seriously helped. Learning to live in the moment rather than making delayed gratification your god opened the door to happiness. Becoming disciplined with an understanding that enjoying the journey was just as important as the result saved you!

Saturn conjunct Pluto

Watching extremes was what you needed to do. Compulsive urges for power sometimes took you to great heights and in some ways met with self-destruction. The wise use of power was the best road to success. You made long lasting pacts with partners. Trust was the big story. You enjoyed great loyalty, but then again you had to watch your back, as betrayal was inevitable. Why? It was usually related to people envious of your position in life. They wanted what you had. Knowing who were your friends and identifying clearly who wasn't was vital. Professional ambition was intense. Whatever roles you took on, you put out great effort. Your expectations of others were tough. Becoming more lenient with loved ones was the way to bring them closer. Learning how to forgive kept relationships going longer. You possessed a mental toughness that wasn't afraid of challenges. What you couldn't control, you needed to learn how to accept, or it eventually destroyed you. Your contemporaries found you to be self-sufficient. When you discovered your life passions, it was a sense of freedom. Self-mastery came when feeling fully empowered.

Saturn oppose Ascendant

Clear definition regarding relationships was what you desired. Letting others get close took time. You didn't like rushing into partnerships. Even in regard to romance you had a sober attitude. This kept you from entering partnerships too compulsively. A fear of closeness did interfere with your happiness occasionally. Though in many instances this simply meant you wanted to get to know someone. Being with strong partners kept you grounded. You needed to be careful not to depend so heavily on others that you forgot how to be self-reliant. Your best relationships were ones where the power was balanced. When you had a lover not clear about their identity, it was essential you didn't try to do everything for them. You had to watch out not to be talked out of a strategy that was a good one. In the long run, being flexible, rather than stubbornly attached to a way of being, made others like you.

Uranus conjunct Node

Independence was a big key to your fulfillment. People had to walk fast and at least a little off center to understand what really drove you. Unpredictable was your name, uniqueness was your game. Your mind quickly cut right through society's rules, and perceived where you needed to be. Compromises were not easy, and too many of them felt stifling. Your mission was to be an innovator and occasionally to cause an upheaval of everyday reality. You followed

a sense of direction that for sure beat to your own drum. Your long-term acquaintances respected your devotion to autonomy. When allowing others to express their own ideas freely, you made interesting links to the unconventional thinkers. It was possible to fit into mainstream society, especially after you made peace with your own true paths. Sooner or later, you realized the need to have stabilizing individuals around you, that is, if you really wanted to settle down. Toning down a me-first attitude did keep people closer. A ferocious need to reinvent yourself manifested when you had outgrown the present.

Neptune trine Node

Destiny had a way of sending you messages about which doors to knock on. You sensed the trails that led to fulfillment. Occasionally you took a detour to see if the scenery was different. You found what you were looking for by not doubting that life would bring the experiences that were needed to fulfill your dreams.

Neptune trine Ascendant

Your intuition was a great guide in taking you toward happiness. It's true that sometimes you took the easy way out. As long as you didn't take running away to the extreme there was no harm. Incorporating a bit of discipline kept you on that straight and narrow highway. You weren't one to miss out on rewarding yourself after a job well done.

Pluto oppose Ascendant

The way you felt about yourself was reflected in your relationships. If happy with your identity, partnerships tended to be stable. When either giving up power too easily or usurping it excessively, your life lacked balance. Finding inner strength kept you from too hungrily searching for it elsewhere. Honest reflection took you to greater clarity. Staying clear of manipulative types maintained your happiness. Dealing with loss was tough because you had a way of getting real attached to people, place and things. Learning to let go was the way to peace.

Ascendant trine Node

There was ease in tuning into those paths that blended nicely with your need for self-discovery. You weren't one to impose your demands on others. Going with the flow and waiting for the right time to make a change was part of the plan. A key was remembering to walk through the door, once you found it was open.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

**2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.
Capricorn on 2nd house:**

You leaned toward the conservative side regarding finances. A fear of losing what you owned drove you to be extra cautious. You took responsibility seriously. Sometimes people found you too controlling of resources. Delayed gratification influenced you to be patient. You tended not to reward yourself enough for performing hard work. You believed in the saying about making money the old-fashioned way in that you earned it. Learning to show affection was a challenge. However, when you became comfortable with yourself, and feeling secure with your livelihood, you could reach out in a warmer way to others. It would have benefited you if you had scrapped certain plans earlier in their implementation. Rigid tendencies found you losing money and time. When you adopted greater flexibility, you were happier and easier to love. You placed importance on traditions. An earthy approach to life needed to be mixed with a bit of your intuition. Your strengths were staying power and reliability.

**3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.
Sagittarius on 3rd house:**

A wandering soul sometimes you were. Your mind was on a quest for high adventure. Whether you had to sail the high seas or cross the tallest mountains, you wanted the challenge. Your mind worked fast. Adaptability you had. Focus was elusive. An eclectic grouping of brain synapses found you not always reasoning in linear fashion. Did you become judgmental? Yes. When you had a dogmatic outlook you were not as much fun. A broad philosophy was what drew individuals to you. You had more options when tolerating new ideas. Agreeing to disagree took you further than having to always be right. When you had to get in the last word, arguments ensued. You liked humor as it took the edge off of your nerves. An inner restlessness made concentration a challenge. You were a force in getting others to think more creatively.

**4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.
Scorpio on 4th house:**

People really had to earn your trust, as you didn't take this side of life lightly. Getting to know you didn't happen overnight. You tended to have a complex emotional nature, though this doesn't infer anything negative. A soul-searching type you were! You could be stubborn when you wanted things on your own terms. You treasured privacy. When you did trust your intuitive instincts, your creative power was much more readily available.

**5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.
Libra on 5th house:**

A romantic you were. You liked the experience of falling in love. Indecision as to how to best express your abilities was a nuisance occasionally. People brought out your greatest talent. You thrived on the meeting of the minds. Your lovers were often dramatic personalities. They could sweep you off of your feet when creating romantic atmospheres. You were ambitious after determining a clear sense of direction. You found creative power through trusting you had what it took to be a success.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.**Virgo on 6th house:**

Perfection was a driving force. It either drove you to accomplish great things or made you miserable. You were better off when accepting your faults and those of people you cared about. Nobody was harder on you than yourself. Workaholism was another tendency. Your dedication to excellence did occasionally get recognition. You felt wise when not letting yourself be stuck in roles that didn't best express your abilities. You were better off when staying mentally preoccupied as it helped regulate your nervous energy. Worry was the most debilitating encumbrance to your well being. When you managed to think positively life was quite pleasurable. You learned best through experience, putting theory to the test of reality.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.**Leo on 7th house:**

Relationships played a major role in discovering your creative potential. You attracted lively and dramatic people. If there was a lesson to learn, it was being more flexible. A clash of wills did occur if you were too stubborn. Sharing center stage with others was a bit testy. Your lovers were wise to find their own platform from which to perform. There were times you made the wrong choices in partners and had to resist their controlling tendencies. You did need to watch out for an obsessive tendency to seek applause at too great an expense. Forgetting those you loved in chasing success left you unhappy. Fulfillment came through putting your own personal style into your ambitions while at the same time paying attention to the people helping you to become a success.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.**Cancer on 8th house:**

You displayed protectiveness of those you loved, and sometimes were too smothering of them with attention. Discovering your own independence was crucial to your fulfillment. You were not the easiest person to get to know. You tended to be secretive until really getting to know someone. You did enjoy in depth emotional bonds with lovers more often than not. You needed a partner able to deal with your turbulent moods, as they could swing back and forth dramatically. You had somewhat of a fear of betrayal by friends or loved ones. You were happier when you didn't worry so much about the motives of others. You showed an amazing ability to bounce back from adversity, turning negatives into positives. When you learned patience your long-range serious plans found roots. Being able to let go of the past challenged you. A sense of rebirth was found through finding a true love with whom to share your life.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.**Gemini on 9th house:**

If they had frequent flyer miles going back a few centuries, you would always have come out a winner. A gypsy at heart you were, even if you couldn't always race around the world following impulsive whims. The world was perceived to be your stage. Being a natural teacher,

your lively intellect inspired others to want to learn. Your belief in ethics and morals made you a critic of those that strayed from the straight and narrow. Sometimes you did grow a bit judgmental. It was hard to out argue you as you could keep one thought ahead. A broad philosophical vision was typical of you. Did you always see reality clearly? No! Occasionally you took a leap of faith for better or worse. Sometimes it brought you good fortune, while in other instances you came up empty. Trying to move into too many directions at once left you frazzled. The drive to walk multiple paths simultaneously was heartfelt.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.**Taurus on 10th house:**

You showed great determination for success. Sensitivity about your status was an ongoing concern. Your focusing power was usually strong. Being entrusted with responsibility a usual pattern. You often chose lifestyles that were sound in nature. You didn't want the embarrassment that failure brought. Staying in confining situations didn't make you all that happy. Moving slowly and deliberately toward your ambitions was your favorite pace. You did race to meet a golden opportunity occasionally. You liked being seen as someone who could shoulder responsibility. Saving for a rainy day was a life reality for you. Change was welcomed if it fit in with your needs, but not so warmly greeted when conflicting with your life. You leaned more toward honoring traditions than fighting them. Commitment to work was generally strong. When you grew too controlling people sought distance from you, physically or emotionally. You were at your best when sharing the spotlight with loved ones and making decisions that created win-win results.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.**Aries on 11th house:**

Rugged individualism colored past incarnations. Waiting for someone else's okay to confirm your decisions was not in your usual thinking. You were easily angered when people opposed your desire to move in new directions. When displaying arrogance you drew angry responses. You found great stimulation through adopting goals that challenged you to act courageously. Impatience with the present caused you to seek ways to bring the future to you faster. It upset those closest to you if you ignored their needs. A love of change just for the experience sometimes brought you into interesting circumstances, and in other instances left your world turned upside down.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.**Pisces on 12th house:**

You kept your dreams to yourself most of the time. Sensitive and dreamy you could be. A strong belief in a higher power or mysterious spiritual forces emanated from your being. It wasn't always simple to be in a relationship. You liked to get to know someone as deeply as possible. Unless you got cold feet! It was in trying to meet each other's expectations that proved testy. It was essential to keep the standards not so high that they were not attainable. Your creative power blossomed when you believed in it. Making your talent visible sometimes took a push from your faith. Staying reasonable about denial and guilt took you far. When you made

the time for those you loved and your highest aspirations, life couldn't have been better!

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Uranus Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared about. Finding the midstream worked the best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise. Your vision of the future was as strong as the ability to remember what gave your imagination an electrifying sensation. Patience took effort!
